

FDLIS MODIFICATIONS

New Voluntary Contribution – Help the Homeless

The Voluntary Contribution screen in FDLIS was modified to allow customers to contribute to the “Help the Homeless” voluntary contribution.



Changes to CDL Disqualification

In an effort to align Florida’s disqualification process with that of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, several changes have been made to the CDL Disqualification process. These changes only affect offenses occurring on or after 07/01/2013.

Two new disposition codes were added. These new codes will be printed on the driver transcript and may be viewed on a history inquiry.

- 835 USE HANDHELD PHONE WHILE OPER A CMV
- 836 TEXTING WHILE OPERATING A CMV

Texting While Driving

The “Florida Ban on Texting While Driving Law” becomes effective on October 1, 2013. This law prohibits the use of a wireless communications device, defined as “any handheld device used or capable of being used in a handheld manner that is designed or intended to receive or transmit text or character-based messages, access or store data, or connect to the Internet or any communications service as defined in s. 812.15 [F.S.,] and that allows text communications” by any person operating a motor vehicle unless the vehicle is stationary or one of 6 exceptions applies. A first violation of this section is punishable as a nonmoving infraction. A second violation within 5 years is considered a moving violation. The provisions of this law are only enforceable as a secondary violation.

Unlawful use of a wireless communications device that results in a crash is 6 points in addition to the points assessed for the related moving violation that results in a crash (4 points). If the texting that resulted in a crash occurred in a school zone, an extra 2 points are also assessed.

To enforce this new law, four new disposition codes were added. These new codes will be printed on the driver transcript and may be viewed on a history inquiry.

- 661 Texting First Offense
- 662 Texting Subsequent
- 663 Texting School Zone Subsequent
- 664 Texting School Zone – 1st

A new correspondence code was also added – 2PTS ADDED AS A RESULT OF TEXTING

If the customer has an email address on file, his most recent active email address will be displayed when this screen is presented. This existing address can be modified or it can be accepted as is.

When you are returned to the Issuance: Personal Information screen, if the customer is eligible to vote, you must answer the question about receiving electronic sample ballots from the Department of State. Continue as usual with the Voter Application section. Notice that the Current, Declined, and Ineligible options are no longer available when the Sample Ballot question has been answered YES.

The answer to the question “Would you like to receive electronic sample ballots from the Department of State?” is prefilled with the answer from the Issuance: Personal Information screen; the email address is also prefilled. These fields cannot be changed on this screen. If they are incorrect, when you return to the Issuance Personal Information screen they can be corrected.

When the Motor Voter receipt is printed, it will show the request for electronic sample ballots and the email address where these electronic ballots will be sent.

New Voluntary Contribution - Help the Homeless

A new voluntary contribution was added. Beginning October 1, 2013, customers may contribute to Help the Homeless.

New Specialty Plate - Freemasonry

A new specialty plate was added to the system. This plate is only eligible for pre-sale vouchers. Until the minimum pre-sale requirement has been met, no inventory will be available for issuance and no personalized reservations will be permitted.

Insurance Message Added to HSMV-82041 and Registrations

The following verbiage will now appear at the bottom of the HSMV 82041 and on registrations for all vehicles which require insurance coverage: 'I understand that my driver license and registrations will be suspended immediately if the insurer denies the insurance information submitted for this registration.'
