# FDLIS MODIFICATIONS

## Sexual Offender, Sexual Predator and Career Offender Reporting Name Changes

Sexual Offenders, Sexual Predators and Career Offenders are required to report a name change to the Department within 48 hours by visiting a Driver License or Tax Collector's office and obtaining a replacement driver license or identification card. If the sexual offender/predator or career offender does not have the money to purchase the credential or necessary documents to become Real ID Compliant, FDLIS will allow an Exam Only transaction to process the name change. The Exam Only transaction will not produce a credential or change the name on the customer's record, but instead, will produce a FDLE letter with the name change information. FDLIS will update the customer's record with Correspondence Code 388 "FDLE Letter Printed". Below are examples of the FDLE letter and a screenshot of the Issuance Exam Only screen with changes:

**FDLE Sexual Offender/Predator and Career Offender File Fix**

When a Sexual Offender, Sexual Predator or Career Offender changes his Mailing, Residential, Location or Temporary Address, the change must be sent to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE). Prior to the update, when processing an Address Change using the Exam Only transaction, the Residential Address was not transmitted to FDLE. Beginning October 1, 2014, all addresses will be sent to FDLE when a Sexual Offender, Sexual Predator or Career Offender changes any of their addresses.

# FRVIS MODIFICATIONS

## County Registration Fee in Hillsborough County

- The County Registration fee (CRF) will be charged on all vessel registrations processed in Hillsborough County including Class A-1 vessels and canoes of any length.

## Red Light Camera Stop by Driver License

- Beginning October 1, 2014, the Department will allow submission of a driver license number with the data sent with a Red Light Camera Stop. In the past, a license plate number was required to be submitted with the Red Light Camera Stop data and the stop was always placed against the primary registrant associated with that license plate. This was causing stops to be placed against rental car companies instead of the individual who violated the law.
- Now, if a driver license number is submitted, the Red light Camera Stop will be placed against the customer associated with that driver license.
- If a driver license number and a license plate number are both submitted, the license plate number will be ignored and the Red Light Customer Stop will be placed against the customer with the specified driver license.
- If a license plate number with a registration use of Short Term Lease is submitted without a driver license number, the system will not place a Red Light Camera Stop. Notification that the stop was not placed will be returned with the explanation that the license plate is associated with a short term lease vehicle.
- If a license plate number is submitted that is NOT associated with a short term lease vehicle, the system will continue to place a Red Light Camera Stop against the primary registrant of that registration.

## **New Specialty Plates**

- The following four new specialty license plates were added to the system:
  - Fallen Law Enforcement Officers (OFR, OFP, OFA)
  - Florida Sheriffs Association (SKR, SKP, SKA)
  - Keiser University (KUR, KUP, KUA)
  - Moffitt Cancer Center (MJR, MJP, MJA)
- These plates become eligible for pre-sales vouchers beginning on October 1, 2014.
- The annual use fee charged for each of these plates is \$25.00.
- Until the minimum pre-sales requirements are met, no inventory will be available and no personalized reservations are allowed.

## **Virtual Office MODIFICATIONS**

### **Personalized License Plates 10-Year Replacement**

At the end of the 10-year license plate cycle, all plates are required to be replaced. In Virtual Office, when a non-personalized plate is up for replacement, it is presumed that the customer desires the same sheeting. Therefore, a new license plate with the same sheeting, but new configuration is issued and mailed to the customer as part of the online renewal transaction. This same process cannot be followed for replacement of a personalized plate, because a reservation must be made to have the plate manufactured with the same configuration and sheeting. Because it is not possible to make a personalized reservation through Virtual Office, the website will now display the following message: "Your personalized license plate is due to be replaced with this renewal. Unfortunately, this cannot be done through Go Renew. Please visit your local county tax collector's office to renew the registration and reserve a replacement personalized license plate."
