SUBJECT: Renamed and Redesigned Specialty License Plates	

Overview:

HB 7005 becomes effective July 1, 2014. This bill renames the **Catch Me Release Me** and **Sportsmen’s National Land Trust** specialty license plates. The new names are **Protect Our Oceans** and **Wildlife Foundation of Florida**, respectively. The organizations are also planning to redesign the graphics of the license plates.

We need your help using the existing inventory before the new license plates become available.

Details:

We are aware that most tax collector offices and tag agencies around the state have an adequate supply of each of these plates. Therefore, if an agency in your county needs additional stock of these license plates before the new plates are available, please contact other agencies in your county, and transfer plates as necessary.

If for some reason you cannot locate any plates, please contact Inventory Control at (850) 617-2809. Inventory Control will fill orders from Central Supply or transfer from county-to-county. We will approve and manufacture personalized license plate orders as usual.
