<b>SUBJECT: Redesigned Military License Plates</b>	

**Overview:**

With support from the Department of Veterans Affairs, the 2014 Legislature passed HB 559 requiring the redesign of a number of military license plates.

The following military license plates will be redesigned: Combat Action Badge, National Guard, Operation Desert Shield, Operation Desert Storm, Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Iraqi Freedom, US Reserve, and Vietnam War Veterans. The license plate for Korean War Veterans will have a name change and redesign.

**Details:**

We need your help using the existing inventory before the new license plates become available.

If an agency in your county needs one of these license plate types before the new plates are available, please contact other agencies in your county, and transfer plates as necessary.

If none is available, contact Inventory Control at (850) 617-2809. Inventory Control will fill orders from Central Supply or transfer from county-to-county. We will approve and manufacture personalized license plate orders as usual.
