MOBILE OFFICE TO BRING MOTORIST SERVICES TO CAMPUS

~ Florida Licensing On Wheels delivers services and promotes safety ~

GAINESVILLE - The Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is pleased to announce its partnership with the University of Florida to bring motorist services directly to faculty and students as they return to campus, saving them a possible trip to our offices.

The Mini-Florida Licensing On Wheels unit will be at Gator 1 Central, Ground Floor, UF Bookstore and Welcome Center adjacent to the J.W. Reitz Union on Museum Road on Aug. 17 - Sept. 4. The hours of operation will be 10 a.m. – 3 p.m., Monday - Friday.

Mini-FLOWs are equipped with the technology and ability to bring valuable motorist services directly to customers. They provide a convenient method to renew a driver license, obtain a duplicate driver license, change a name or address on a driver license, get an identification card, renew a vehicle registration and purchase a specialty license plate. Mini-FLOWs also offer the Department's critical safety initiatives such as Emergency Contact Information registration and safety campaigns by the Florida Highway Patrol.

The Department implemented the Emergency Contact Information system nearly three years ago to allow Florida motorists to voluntarily register their emergency contact information either online or in an office using their Florida driver license or ID card number. The information can then be accessed only by law enforcement officers to find designated contacts in the case of an emergency.

Customers wishing to obtain a driver license or ID card must bring a certified copy of their birth certificate, proof of their Social Security number and proof of the residential address they wish to be printed on their license. The Department provides a complete list of acceptable documents online at www.flhsmv.gov/ddl/address.html. In addition to cash and personal checks, the Department accepts the following credit cards: MasterCard, American Express and Discover.
